NOTIFICATION OF AMENDMENT TO APPLICATION Application No.: 20/01453/OUT Proposal: Outline application for creation of a holiday village and eco-park comprising the erection of up to 450 holiday lodges, erection of a hotel (Class C1), marketplace (Classes E and Sui Generis), virtual reality wildlife experience (Class F1), artisan workers pods (Class E) with ancillary service and storage, hard

and soft landscaping and drainage works and water storage attenuation ponds with full planning permission sought for the creation of a vehicular access off the A6 and across Lancaster Canal Site Address: Land At Home Farm, Ellel Grange, Main Road, Galgate, Lancaster Lancashire LA2 OHN The parish council object to the planning application.

There is an ethylene pipe under where the proposed site will be. The parish council would like more information on how the planning application will implement this pipe, as it cannot be moved.

The site is in flood zone 2 & 3 - what will be actively done to prevent flooding and how will this be maintained and managed in the future.

There are major concerns over the volume of traffic the holiday village will create from both sides of the A6 through the village of Galgate and at the motorway junction.

How will the site work in harmony with the wildlife, with so many buildings and visitors affecting their natural habitat. What biodiversity and environmental mitigation will be implemented and assessed.

There is no permitted access to the site - please could an update be given on how the developers will access the land.

There has been no liaison with any community member, neighbour of the development proposal or the parish council since the original application was submitted.

Previous questions raised have not been responded to by the planners or developers.
