151/17 Precept and budget preparation.

The clerk had previously circulated the budget and precept figures for consideration. The parish council requested a more detailed projected income as well as expenditure for the next meeting. It was resolved that the base rate be raised by 1% per household based on band D. The clerk cannot calculate the precept until Lancaster City Council provide the tax base figures. 154/17 Village Hall solar panels income update.

The clerk has raised a cheque to send to LCC. This should satisfy Eon's and Ofgem's criteria regarding the required payback contribution.

155/17 Ellel Quarry traffic.

Cllr Greenwood reported that wagons from Ellel quarry have been using routes around the parish that they shouldn't use, including Whams Lane. He has spoken to the quarry company and they said they would monitor their wagons. Cllr Greenwood asked the councillors to note if they see the wagons on restricted roads.

156/17 Noticeboard maintenance.

Cllr Collinson will complete the repairs, sanding and staining of the Galgate noticeboard.

157/17 Dolphinholme sign replacement.

Cllr Collinson has contacted the original supplier of the dolphin, Mr G Whittley, who on his return from holiday will make a new a new dolphin to the original specification.

158/17 Recreational field area and recreation rooms.

Bowling Club gate.

Three quotes are needed for the clearing of the pathway and the new gate. Cllr Helm is applying to the wind turbine fund for a grant but needs costs to put into the application. James Gardner and Paul Dearden will be contacted to tender and Cllr Wilson will enquire about a third contractor.

Heaters for the rec rooms.

The clerk was asked to circulate the quote for the Dolphinholme Village Hall heaters to the parish council for consideration.

Ongoing repair & maintenance review.

The cricket changing room needs cleaning and maintenance. The parish council will meet with the cricket team representative to discuss the use of the rec rooms for the upcoming season.

CCTV camera quote.

The cost of a new camera and system installation on the recreation room roof would cost £650.00. The parish council would like a wireless camera placing, to connect to the village hall system which would be approximately £160.00.

It was resolved that the clerk purchase a CCTV camera for the rec rooms roof.

159/17 Zipwire grant update.
